### Operations Highlights

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- Completed 3,500 + hours of service touching over 30,000 lives in the South Bay
  - Provided holiday gifts to over 1,600 children through the Sugar Plum Tree Program
  - Organized and volunteered at Summer Arts Program that served 60+ underserved children and 25 senior citizens living in a low-income senior facility
  - Delivered over 600 gallons of milk, over 2,000 hot meals and 300 hand-made Valentine's Day cards to homeless individuals and shut-ins through Project: NEEDS and Meals on Wheels

### Community Service Highlights

- Volunteered at Special Olympics host town activities, Pediatric Therapy's Camp Escapades, Halloween Ball and Parade, Volunteered at Exceptional Kids Organization (EKPTO) Prom and Family Fun Day and Volunteered at Family Promise of the South Bay's Cardboard Box City
- Participated in Heal the Bay beach clean up collecting over 400 lbs of trash
- Held blanket/sweater drives for Project: NEEDS and Failure to Thrive and held product drives for: Beacon House, Little Sisters of the Poor, Redondo Cancer Support Community, Family Promise, Casa de Los Angelicas and Rainbow House
- Provided weekly product drop offs to: 1736 House, Failure to Thrive, Harbor Interfaith Services, Project New Hope, Project: NEEDS, Rainbow Family Services and Richstone Family Center
- The Community Outreach Committee completed a waiting room maker-over at Pediatric Therapy Network, a library-painting project at St. Anthony's of Padua, a holiday sing along at Lomita Manor and a For the Love of Books event at Pages Bookstore. They also hosted Teamworks Beach day for 75 underserved children in the South Bay
- In partnership with South Bay Children Health Center over 100 hours were donated to 35 dental screening clinics in Title 1 elementary schools in the South Bay

### Philanthropic Highlights

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- \$3,800+ in casework programs to help 3 families in need
  - \$16,000+ in outreach to 76 children for new school clothing, backpacks full of supplies and lunchboxes
  - \$61,000+ in value distributed to over 292 children/113 families through Holiday Baskets Program
  - 214 children in local school districts received Payless Shoe gift cards through School Nurse Program
  - \$12,700+ in funds raised from local companies for Holiday Baskets through the Employee Giving Program
  - \$235,000+ in college scholarships to 44 students
  - \$47,500+ to 34 agencies through Sandpiper Juniors, Associates & Sandpipers' Community Contribution Grants
  - \$47,500 granted to Sandpipers South Bay Community Fund by Sandpipers and Sandpiper Associates
  - \$34,000 granted to 2016-2017 Sandpipers programs
